Deck: Everyday Witch Tarot



Overall Answer:

To answer your question, yes you are going the right direction in life. As far as you career, if you just switched - you will blossom once you get through the new period. If you are at a long-term career - it is either time to change fields or change positions, but something has to change.

How I got here:

In this reading, we will focus on cards 1, 2, 7, and 8, but I will lightly touch on almost all of them.

"This Covers Them"

-The general energy covering everything. The current the reading flows down.





The reversed Two of Pentacles suggests a struggle with balance and priorities. You may be feeling overwhelmed by juggling multiple responsibilities. When this card is reversed, you see the keywords of enforced gaiety and simulated enjoyment. This has the energy of a tired performer, simply over putting on the show. I'm not sure if it is in regard to your career or life, but I think it is important to recognize it for what it is, so you can figure out how to move forward. Are you bored? If so, why? Let me tell you some stories so I can get my point across:

I noticed I was bored with my bracelet store, not because I was bored with bracelets, but because I had solved the puzzle of learning to run the store. I am glad I differentiated the two and why I was bored, or I may have given up bracelets instead of giving myself a new challenge to learn with the store.

I have worn many hats in this life, but the hat I wore the longest was waitress. This was not an issue of needing a challenge, like the bracelets, this was burnout I refused to acknowledge. I found myself getting way too upset when people did not specify how they wanted their steak cooked. I was tired of asking. I was tired of asking if they wanted lemon with their tea. I wound up getting fired for having to be restrained from fighting a customer. I should have acknowledged my burnout.

I bring all this up because I notice the eight of cups is reversed below this card, also highlighting a need to walk away and move on. Make sure you walk away from the right thing, you will know, there won't be any wondering.

Card

"This Crosses Them"

-Obstacles, if there are any.



Crossing you is the Three of Wands, indicating a desire for expansion and growth. As an obstacle this could mean a few things. In relation to the imbalance represented by the reversed Two of Pentacles there may be some challenges in pursuing these ambitions effectively. In general, however, this could be to say that being future minded is an obstacle for you. Having the foresight to see something to through is something I struggle with at times, as well. Honestly, I couldn't tell you how many "this is going to be my big break," projects that are sitting unfinished. Either I lose wind, or I run into complications I could have known about with the smallest bit of planning and research. Intuitively, I feel like it is that. I believe what you are trying to manifest, or the direction you are trying to go, has curves you aren't prepared for. That isn't to say it's bad, or not going to work, it is just a heads up to look a little further into this. Not just the next step, but the next 8 steps. All that said, I need to look further in the reading to be 100% sure, this is just my initial reaction.



The Past





Behind you, the reversed Six of Pentacles suggests there was an unequal amount of give and take. Perhaps you realized you were not getting paid fairly for your time and skillset. Or you may have set some boundaries in your relationships that were taking more than they gave. Whatever the case, I am glad you noticed the unfairness and recognized your worth. As my daughter would say, "Slay, Queen."

Beneath you, the reversed Eight of Cups suggests avoidance or denial of your desires or emotions to move on. As I mentioned earlier, it's essential for you to confront any inner turmoil or dissatisfaction to move forward authentically.

Your Conscious Workings



The High Priestess crowning you highlights that you have been following your intuition. If your question is, am I on the right path, then this card tells us, yes. You are tapped into your higher and lower self, and they are working in unison. Your intuition is on point right now, so make sure to continue following it.



"Themselves."

-Your attitude and actions towards the situation. This is also the advice card,





The reversed four of cups is a pretty good card, it brings hope for a return of motivation and satisfaction. As advice this card reminds us to look up and around. Notice how he is so fixated on the empty cups that he does not notice the new, full cup being handed to him? Don't focus on what is wrong or on what you lack. Look for the next opportunity.

*My intuition is dinging about the woman handing the cup to the man in the card opportunity from the mouth of a woman.



"Their House."

-The environmental factors. i.e. influenced opinions from friends, social media, music. Sometimes this card will represent your literal house or surroundings.



Typically, this position is more about your environmental factors and influences, but in this spread I have tweaked it for a message from the universe. This card is meant to show how the universe would nudge you to get your attention that something is for you, or to give you a direct message.

Message:

The reversed Ten of Swords signals the end of a challenging period. While it may have been painful, there's a sense of closure and the opportunity for a fresh start.

How the Universe would give you a sign:

The Ten of Swords as a sign is a weird one. If you see someone with ten swords in their back, you will know this is for you! lol I am just kidding. If this card were a sign, it would be in sudden endings and closures. If you are getting closure on something you did not expect to get closure on, you know you closed that cycle out the correct way. Loop complete, lesson learned. If a lot of things start ending, or not working out, you can take comfort in knowing new things are on the way, with things that will work!



Future Cards





In your immediate future, there may be some turbulence on a group project. I feel like this will be at work, but I also kind of feel like it will be between sisters. If you have sisters, probably them. Anyway, when the three of pentacles is reversed it hints at poor collaboration and people not respecting each other's work and opinions. If this does unfold, you can lighten the tension with proper communication.

In the more long-term future, things work out! The Sun is such a wonderful card, it hints that you will be well taken care of, satisfied, and enjoying the warmer sides of life. Whatever you are doing, keep it up!

In Conclusion:

Overall, this spread indicates you have some truths to face regarding why you feel the way you feel. It also points to satisfaction coming your way once you face those truths.

Not speaking directly, it is hard for me to tell if these events have already come to pass or will be happening in the future. If you just got to a new job, I think that three of pentacles tension point will be once things change and you feel confident there. If you have been at your job a long time, like I mentioned in the overall answer, something has to change.

*Oh, one last thing, do not be scared of how you will act on your emotions. I can see in one position not mention (card 9) that you are worried about possibly lashing out, or your emotions getting the best of you somehow. This won't happen so long as you face your emotions and figure out why they are there like I mentioned in the bored at work examples.
